

### **Question?**




Are believers getting worse at recognizing sound doctrine and genuine Bible teaching?

The Judgement that Jesus brought into this world was the condemnation of sin that would lead people to faith. This judgement was so that we who are born into darkness and cannot see, may see,


Everyone who says I believe will gain Spiritual sight.

He said, if they were totally blind, they would have not the sin of rejecting Him.


But they insisted, we see therefore, Jesus declared that their sin of rejecting Christ remains.

You search the Scriptures because you think they give you eternal life;


But the Scripture point to me!

But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life.






### **Self Evaluations**

## 1. Have I stopped listening, to God's Voice?




John 9: 1-3

Now as Jesus passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth. And His disciples asked Him, saying, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"

Jesus answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him.



## 1. Have I stopped listening, to God's Voice?



John 9: 6 – 7


Jesus made some saliva cakes and put it on his eyes.

And He said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which is translated, Sent). So, he went and washed, and came back seeing.

For the man who was born blind to receive his healing, first, he had to listen to the voice of God and then walk by faith to the pool of Siloam believing that he would See, once the mud was gone.



## Karma Theology




Karma Theology when favorable or unfavorable things happen to people or themselves.

We should be asking the Lord to give me strength to endure the trial and a clearer perspective on what is happening.


And say to God nevertheless, your will be done, Lord!

So, praise Him in the middle of it. We always want to fix ourselves, but I reminded of Psalm 46:10 Be still and know that I am God.




# 1. Have I stopped listening, to God's Voice?




Ephesians 1: 4-6






John 9:11

He wouldn't budge


John 9:25

<u>I was blind, now I see.</u>"








This man had a testimony of what Jesus had done for him that was very simple and yet very effective. When people asked him what happened, he just told them what Jesus had done for him.

His testimony was strong even though he had no seminary; he had no theological education or college; he had no discipleship training or Sunday School or even a 1-hour testimony workshop to help him! he only knew one thing:

"I once was blind, but now I see"





John 9:32-34


Since the world began it has been unheard of that anyone opened the eyes of one who was born blind.

If this Man were not from God, He could do nothing.

The Pharisees finally gave up.

They threw the once-blind man out of the synagogue.






John 9:35

Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him, "Do you believe in the Son of God?


Jesus found and said, "if they don't want you, I will take you.

Those who are cast out for Jesus' sake lose nothing but gain a great blessing in His personal welcome and fellowship.










#### Here's the bottom line:

If you're willing to confess your blindness, your lack of faith, understanding and your dependence on the mercies of God. God will open your eyes and show you the way.

In the eyes of Faith, Blindness is a Virtue

Jesus said, "If you were blind, you would have no sin; but since you say, 'We see', your sin remains."







to draw out of you.






Ephesian 2:10

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.






John 9:39
