





Can The Holy Spirit Depart from the Church?








Before we can understand if the Holy Spirit departs from the church, we must first understand the role or work of The Holy Spirit, and the move of The Holy Spirit.

A: Holy Spirit His Role

» The spirit of God is the Executive arm of The Divinity.


» HIS distinct role is to accomplish the unified will of the father and the son and to be in personal relationship with both.



"I Tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away, for IF I do not go away, the HELPER will not come to you, but IF I go, I will send him to you."






- Here "helper" is translated in Greek word as PARAKLETOS.
- It refers to one who would be an advocate.
- In context, it speaks of comfort, of protection, of counsel, and of guidance.
- in John 14 He is "The spirit of truth"




(John 16:13-14)


"and I will not hide my face anymore from them, when I pour out my spirit upon the house of Israel declares The Lord God"





- 1: It is very important that we recognize the identity of this helper...
- He can be grieved.(Ephesians 4:30)
 - 2: He can be quenched in terms of the exercise of His will.
- "Do not quench the Spirit." (I Thess. \$:156 can be resisted, "You stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always resist the Holy Spirit; as your Fathers did, so do you." (Act 7:51)

B: Holy Spirit His move

1: The creative work of God is carried out

by the Spirit. (Genesis 1:1-2)

- Hebrew word "spirit" here is RUACH, which


also can mean "Breath".

- The ruach Elohim, "The breath of the

Almighty", is the agent in creation
2: The resuscitative work of God is carried out


by spirit (Ezekiel 37:1-10) VS 5, "Thus says the Lord God to these bones: behold, I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live."






3: The impossible work of God is carried by Spirit (Zechariah 4:6-7)

- "Then he said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: Not by might, nor by power, but by spirit, says the Lord of the hosts. Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain. And he shall bring forward the top stone amid shouts of grace, grace to it."




4: The spirit of God has the characteristics of wind, "The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes, so it is with everyone who is born of the spirit." Act 2:1-4 John 3:8.



To understand the character of the spirit of God, understand the wind.

- 1) Unpredictable: John 3:8, Job 9:10, Romans 11:33
- 2) Unstoppable: The move of God is unstoppable, ", I work and who can turn in back" Isaiah 43:13 Henceforth I am he, there is none who can deliver from my hand
- 3) Expeditious: (Rapid, quick, swift) 500 per hour. Whenever God is set to move, His moves are unstoppable.
- 4) Recognizable- John 3:8, anywhere God moves there is something to see and something to hear. (Luke 7:22-24)
- 5) Forcible- He is forcible, powerful (Act 1:8)






C:Can the Holy Spirit ever leave a believer? Absolutely Not.

- The Holy spirit dwells believer permanently – Guarantees our internal Salvation.
- However, disobedience and resistance to God's word and Spirit could suppress, grieve, and quench the activity of the Holy spirit

There are five works of the Holy Spirit in a believer's life.

- 1. The indwelling work: Permanent Resident (John 14:16)
- 2. The sealing work: Divine stamp, guarantees approval (Ephesians 1:13-14)
- 3. The filing work: Divine control in believers' life (Luke 1:15; Act 4:31, 13:52)
- 4. The sanctifying work: A divine consecration and transformation (2 Thessalonians 2:13; 2 Corinthians 3:18, 1 peter 1:2)
- 5. The empowering work: A divine anointing (John 14:26, Act 1:8, 1 John 2:27)
