





Obedience – God's Love Language

John 20: 30-31

30. And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book;

31. but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

Obedience – God's Love Language

1. The Social Test – Loving the Brethren

20. If someone says, "I love God," but hates a fellow brother, that person is a liar; for if we don't love people we can see, how can we love God, whom we cannot see?

21. And he has given us this command: Those who love God must also love their fellow brother.

Obedience – God's Love Language

Deuteronomy 4:2 – The Word of God

You shall not add to the word which I am command you, nor take away from it, that you may keep the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you.



Obedience – God's Love Language

Sight, though not necessary to affection, it does aid it
Seeing is an incentive to love.

Things unseen rarely catch the mind or our hearts.
Out of sight out of mind.

If we do not love our Bro & Sis, the visible representatives of God,
how can we love God, the *Invisible One*?

Obedience – God's Love Language

Definition

Hate – To dislike intensely or passionately; feel extreme aversion for or extreme hostility toward; to detest.

❑ G3404 miseō (me-se-o) detest, love less, esteem less.

Brother – G80 Adelphos (ä-del-fo's) A brother, member of the same religious community, especially a fellow-Christian.

Obedience – God's Love Language

John 13:34-35

34. A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

35. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

Obedience – God's Love Language

1 John 5:1

1. Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves Him who begot also loves him who is begotten of Him.

Obedience – God's Love Language

It is **God** who determines who the other family members are, **not us!**

We are to simply called to **Accept** and **Love** them.

*If we Love the One who Conceives the child,
we'll surely Love the Child who was Conceived.*

Obedience – God's Love Language

2. The Moral Test - Obeying Gods commands

2. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and keep His commandments.

3. For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.

Obedience – God's Love Language

1 Corinthians 13: 4 - 7

Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up;

does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil;

does not rejoice in sin, but rejoices in the truth;
bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Obedience – God's Love Language

Matthew 22: 37- 38

37. You shall love the Lord your God with all your Heart, with all your Soul, and with all your Mind.'

38. This is the first and great commandment.

39. And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'

Obedience – God's Love Language

The commandments of the Lord are the things which are best for us, and the things in which our **New Nature**, the **New Creation** takes delight in doing.

When we are born again, we are given New hearts – **Hearts** which by instinct wish to please God.

Obedience – God's Love Language

When you have love for someone, it seems little trouble to go to a lot of difficulty to help or please that person.

You enjoy doing it.

However, if you had to do it for one that you did not love,
*you would be **complaining**
the whole time.*
