
Epic Challenges . . . The Church


I. The Rise of Saul: Verses










II. The Fall of Saul

Being a poor leader






II. The Fall of Saul Consequences

- God uses a harmful Spirit to Torment Saul






Regret:

Nacham: (Hebrew) which translates to deep sigh as in great sorrow. God was grieved by Saul and his actions.






III. Saul's Narrative as a tool A.) A Warning

- Deal with your issues and sin






III. Saul's Narrative as a tool

B.) Introspection and Reflection

Introspection is the observation or examination of one's own mental and emotional state, mental processes, etc.; the act of looking within oneself.






III. Saul's Narrative as a tool

- B.) Introspection and Reflection
- Do you quench the Holy Spirit?
 Reflection:

Psalm 27:14 "Wait for the Lord;
be strong, and let your heart take courage;
wait for the Lord!"

Isaiah 40:31 "But those who wait on the Lord
Shall renew their strength;
They shall mount up with wings like eagles,
They shall run and not be weary,
They shall walk and not faint."





III. Saul's Narrative as a tool B.) Introspection and Reflection

Do you care too much of other opinions?


Reflection:

Acts 20:30 "Also from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves."

Philippians 4:8 " Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these

things "






III. Saul's Narrative as a tool

- B.) Introspection and Reflection
- Do you trust God or yourself?
 Reflection:

Psalm 46:10 "Be still, and know that I am God;
I will be exalted among the nations,
I will be exalted in the earth!"

Proverbs 3: 5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;
6 in all your ways submit to him,
and he will make your paths straight."






III. Saul's Narrative as a tool

- B.) Introspection and Reflection
 - Am I a poor witness?
 Reflection:
- 2 Cor. 5:20 "We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God."






III. Saul's Narrative as a tool

- B.) Introspection and Reflection
- Am I setting up idols for myself?
 Reflection:

Deuteronomy 4:23 "Be careful not to forget the covenant of the Lord your God that he made with you; do not make for yourselves an idol in the form of anything the Lord your God has forbidden."





III. Saul's Narrative as a tool

- B.) Introspection and Reflection
 - Consequences as believers
 Disaster.

Loss.


Regret.

Pain.






III. Saul's Narrative as a tool

- C.) Transformative Change
 - The Table is set for you
 - God does not make mistakes
- Change is incremental and must be done daily
 - Have a growth mindset
 - Humble yourself before God






IV. Conclusion
